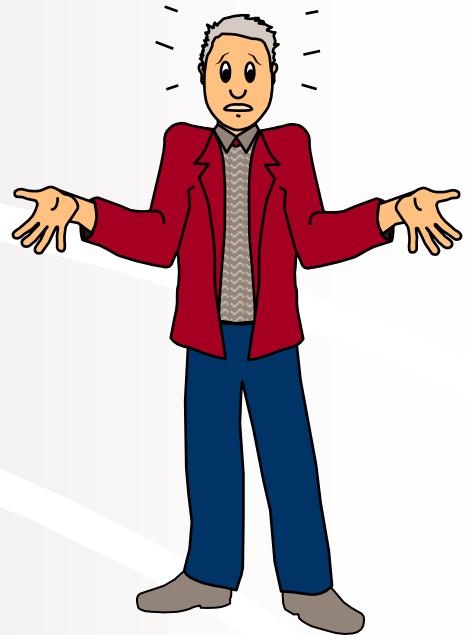

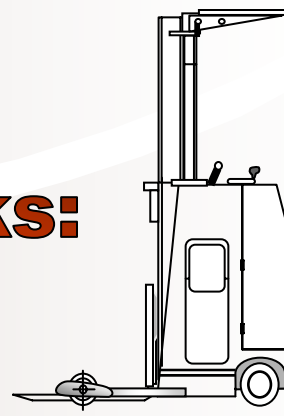
Safety Training:

What's So Good About It?

- **Improves Operator Awareness**
- **Promotes a safer work environment for all employees**
- **Helps reduce the number and severity of accidents**
- **Can reduce maintenance costs**
- **Helps reduce insurance and worker's compensation costs**
- **Satisfies the OSHA regulations and applicable industry standards**



Powered Industrial Lift Trucks: New OSHA Rules



Under the new OSHA law, all forklift operators must have received training by December 1, 1999. Operators hired after December 1, 1999 must receive training before they are assigned to operate a powered industrial lift truck.

Operators should be re-evaluated every three years and documentation must be kept on file. Re-training may be necessary under certain circumstances. (i.e., an accident occurs, near-miss, the operator changes equipment or uses different attachments)



This new law applies to 29 CFR Parts 1910, 1915, 1917, 1918 and 1926. Training is required on all powered lift trucks - including rough terrain forklifts

Self-Propelled Aerial Work Platforms: OSHA & ANSI Rules

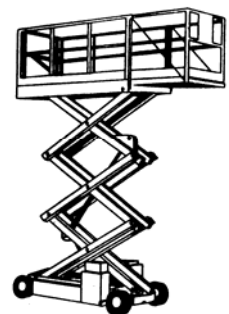
Training requirements and safety guidelines for proper use and operation of aerial work platforms are provided by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI).

Contrary to belief, OSHA recognizes and enforces training requirements as outlined in the ANSI standards for self-propelled aerial work platforms. Under their General Duty Clause, OSHA can levy fines for non-compliance with training requirements.

Employers (defined as “users”) have a responsibility to ensure that operators are trained and made aware of responsibilities for operators. Training must include certain topics as outlined by ANSI.

The operator should be retrained, based on the user’s observation and evaluation of the operator.

A record of the trainee’s aerial work platform instruction shall be maintained by the user for at least four (4) years.

- Under the new OSHA rules for operator training, safety training for forklift operators is a Federal Law.
- Under the OSHA General Duty Clause, Subpart C, operators of aerial work platforms and other types of equipment are required to receive safety training
- An OSHA fine for untrained operators of forklifts and aerial work platforms can cost thousands of dollars.
- Recently, a fine was issued for non-compliance with the new OSHA training law for forklift operators. The fine was \$3,500 - that's 28 times more than what it would cost to train one operator! ¹
- Most industrial accidents are *operator induced*
- Construction workers have one of the highest fatality rates - 39.5 deaths per 100,000 workers. The leading fatal event: Falls ²
